**Notice of Change to the Customer
Charge for Customers up to 73,200 kWh
per annum for North of England
Distribution Network**

**To Apply from
1 April 2007**

LDZ Customer Charges up to 73,200 kWh per annum

For supply points with an AQ of less than 73,200 kWh per annum, the customer charge has been a commodity charge (CCO). With effect from 1 April 2007, this will be converted into an equivalent capacity charge.

Initially this charge will be billed on the same charge code as the use of system capacity charge for domestic customers (ZCA) in order to provide time for the industry to develop a separate Customer Capacity charge and to update their computer systems accordingly.

This charge will be billed on the same ZCA code as the existing use of system domestic capacity charge. Therefore the total unit charge billed for this code will be 0.1031 pence per peak day kWh per day (i.e. the current use of system domestic capacity charge of 0.0517 pence per peak day kWh per day plus the LDZ Customer charge of 0.0514 pence per peak day kWh per day).

As a result, the CCO charge code charge will be set to zero.

For the avoidance of doubt, the customer charges for supply points from 73,200 kWh per annum and higher remain unchanged. Please see the full customer charging statement for 1 October 2006 charges for further detail.
