

Gas Supply alteration price list 2010

The cost of moving your gas supply is in three parts:

1. Basic fee of moving your existing gas service pipe
2. The cost of providing any extra pipe you need
3. Reconnection fees – for moving and reconnecting your meter

The **basic fee** includes the cost of moving your service pipe to its new position and laying up to 3m of extra pipe. Everyone needs to pay the basic cost.

The **extra service pipe length charge** is the additional cost per metre of service pipe we need to lay over and above the 3m included in the basic fee. Multiply this figure by each additional metre (or part of a metre) of pipe you need.

There are two types of **reconnection fee**: partial or full. If you prefer you can ask another company to move and/or reconnect your meter. It's up to you.

Includes moving your meter and connecting it to the external and internal pipes and checking your appliances to make sure they have been re-lit correctly.

This is not available if your meter is moving more than 2 metres and you should choose the partial reconnection option.

Partial reconnection	£65.13

Includes moving your meter and connecting it to the external service pipe.

We **will not** connect your meter to any internal pipework or ensure that your appliances have been re-lit correctly. You will need to arrange for another CORGI registered engineer to carry out this part of the work.

This option should be chosen if your meter is moving more than 2 metres from its existing position.

If you don't want any reconnection done and choose to pay only the standard charge, then we will leave the meter in its existing position and lay only the pipework to where the meter is to be moved to.

You will need to employ an Ofgem Approved Meter Installer (OAMI) to move and reconnect your meter to its new position.

Eligibility criteria

The standard prices on this sheet apply to works which fulfil the following criteria. If the work you need is different please contact us before filling in your application.

1. Your existing service pipe is no more than 32mm (one inch) in diameter.
2. Your existing gas service operates at a pressure of below 7barg.
3. The point at which the existing service pipe enters your property is no more than 3m above ground level.
4. The point you want the new service pipe to enter your property is no more than 3m above ground level.
5. You will not need more than 20m of new service pipe.
6. Your service pipe supplies no more than two meter points.
7. There are no unusual security or similar access restrictions (e.g. on a military base).
8. You do not expect any unusual health, safety or environmental risks to affect the work e.g. asbestos, dust, scaffolding which has been erected by others etc.
