

Form of consent

The quotation we have provided you with assumes that we will lay gas pipes in land in either shared ownership, land owned by a third party or in land owned by the end user. Northern Gas Networks Ltd requires that reasonable provisions to protect the gas pipe(s) are agreed upon. In this instance this provision is obtained by using a Form of Consent as it is deemed a Deed of Easement is not required.

The enclosed consent map shows the length of pipe (highlighted in yellow) that requires the Form of Consent.



If you wish to accept this quotation you must ensure that steps 1-2 below are fully completed and return the original copies of the documents along with your quotation acceptance form.

1. All landowners must fill in the required fields on the 'Form of Consent' form and sign & date the form. It is very important that this document is completed by ALL the landowners who are impacted by the proposed (highlighted) pipe route.

2. All landowners must sign the copy of the design proposal map that shows the 'Consent Drawing' label and shows the relevant pipe highlighted.

The standard Deed of Grant of Easement has been included although we do not require you to complete or return the document – it has been included for reference purposes only.

Please be aware that variations of the Form of Consent are not permitted except with the express consent in writing of Northern Gas Networks.
